SYNOPSIS for PROGRAMME:- Various episodes are here depicted, in musical form, illustrating some of the experiences of our gallant soldiers in The Great War of 1914-1918. (1) War Clouds gather. The boom of guns is heard across the Channel. (2) The Mobilisation. (3) Departure of Troops to the strains of "British Grenadiers." (4) Going Aboard. "The Anchor's Weighed. The Farewell. (5) Crossing the Channel. (6) "England expects that every man will do his duty." (7) Arrival in France. The march to the front. (8) The "Alarm" is sounded. (9) The Battle. (10) "Cease Firing." (11) A drum-head Service. (12) End of the War. "Fall in!" Troops return to England. Note the English, Scotch, Irish and Welsh Brigades. (13) "Tommy" comes marching home again! Hurrah! (14) "See the Old Heroes Come!" (15) "Rule, Britannia." (16) Finale.
